



Cake Stall Entry Form

We would love for you to participate in “The Great Jindalee Bake Off” Cooking Competition.

The cake stall this year is “**Mad Hatters’ Tea Party**” and in the spirit of the mad hatter we would like to encourage everyone to get creative in decorating their entries in the “Myths & Legends” Fete theme.

How it works:

- Every year level will be allocated a **baking category** and provided with a list of **suggestions** of what to bake. Please refer to the reverse side for category allocation and suggestions.
- Our young chefs themselves are requested to choose what **they** would like to make from **within the category allocated to their year level**. Eg If you have been given Biscuits as your category, you decide what style/flavour biscuit to bake (Anzac/ Choc Chip/ Shortbread/ Custard etc). Please refer to the reverse side for further details.
- Return your completed entry form **by Friday 27th July** to your class teacher or the office. An entry form box will be placed in the office.
- A baking kit containing cake box or tray for decorating along with further information will be distributed to all entrants on **Friday 10th August**. Please advise if you do not receive this kit ASAP after this date.
- Make this special item (with the help of an adult), and then bring your entries to the school hall on **Friday 24th August from 2:30pm until 6pm. Please note - entries will not be accepted on Saturday morning (the day of the fete).**

Entries are not tasted. Judges look for enthusiasm in the decoration of the box or tray in the **Myths & Legends** theme and the overall appearance of the baking.

Prizes

Judging will take place on Saturday morning prior to the start of the Fete. All of the delicious creations will then be sold at the “**Mad Hatter’s Tea Party**” stall.

- **Class Winners** - the two best entries from each class wins a prize!
- **Best in Show** - will be awarded to the best entry from all entries received.
- **Principal’s award** - will be awarded to two best entries judged by the Principal from all entries received.
- **Best Class** - will be awarded to the class with the highest percentage of entries. This class wins a cake to share!!!!!!(*baking must be received – not just the entry form. Winning class is decided **after** the Fete based on percentage)

AND

- **Each participant who provided their baking entry** – will receive an ice-block from the Tuck Shop.

We look forward to receiving your yummy creation, so roll up your sleeves and get cooking!
